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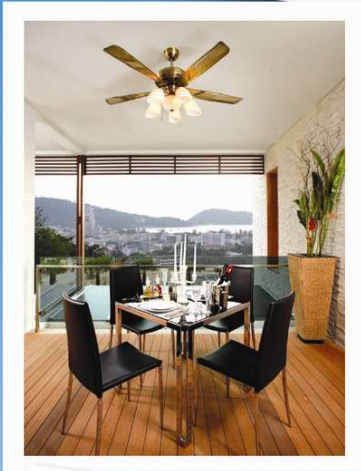
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A hidden masterpiece rises

HIDDEN away, high on a hill, overlooking Patong and the sea beyond, a luxury resort set in over 15 acres, has rapidly taken shape. Due to be completed by the end of 2010, it's destined to raise the bar for accommodation in Patong and Phuket.

The living area has high ceilings, cleverly designed for subtle lighting. A huge luxurious leather sofa faces a large TV and entertainment centre against an olive green wall. Other well-selected furnishings and accessories complete a real home style feeling.

The meticulously fitted kitchen is real quality and comes complete with an array of in-built appliances and utensils.

Each bedroom provides full length wardrobes, luxury furnishings and well appointed and tastefully designed bathrooms. Outside on each terrace one can relax in the Jacuzzi, have a cool drink and take in the amazing views. The apartment comes fully furnished, with an array of TV and telephone points in each room, built in air-con and wireless internet.

The total living area for this two-bedroom unit is a generous 148sqm, with a price set at 17,500,000 baht for a freehold condominium ownership title.

Other future additions coming on line soon will be built-to-order bespoke villas, a large reception area, huge common area pool, international club house, fitness centre, spa, squash courts, poolside café, wine cellar, restaurant and minimart.
