# Golf course villa's a work of art

**T**HIS amazing villa is just a short chip over one of the beautiful lakes of the nine-hole course at the Phuket Country Club.

It's perfect for the golfer who doesn't want to waste valuable golfing time travelling to and from the course.

Approaching from the front, it's hard to imagine what beauty lies behind the high stone wall which surrounds three sides of the property.

The electronic gate opens to reveal a true masterpiece, with plenty of parking for two cars and an adjacent storage and cleaning room.

The high front doors open into the spacious living room, and you immediately realise what a special place this is.

The floors throughout have been finished in highly polished maka wood, and complement the very tasteful furniture.

All the doors and windows run from floor to ceiling, creating an expanse of height and light throughout.

The entire wall at the back of the villa is finished in glass, with an uninterrupted view of the golf course.

The living room includes the entertainment, dining and kitchen areas.

The theme of polished wood and decorative art is continued, blending these areas into each other.

A large LCD TV and surround sound system are perfect for entertaining, with a beautiful table and matching chairs from Chiang Mai to make a dinner part that much more special.

There are two kitchens, one for serving, and one for cooking.

Both are finished in granite, maka wood and fitted with Teka kitchen appliances.

A bedroom is set off to the side of the kitchen area, which is currently being used as an office.

Out in the garden area, there is an infinity swimming pool and sala where you can sit for hours watching golfers chasing that ever-elusive hole-in-one, or the black swans gliding across the lakes and water hazards.

The light and colours are constantly changing as they reflect off the greens and water.

Back inside, an impressive staircase leads to an upstairs lounge area with a sofa and a coffee table.

Three bedrooms surround this area, and each comes complete with built in wardrobes, beds and side tables.

The ceilings are all raised and dressed in wood, creating an impressive centre piece to each room.

The master bedroom has a large balcony where you can enjoy an evening glass of wine and take in the views, or if you prefer, you can sit in the bathtub and enjoy the panoramic view through the large window.

The villa has been designed to create an open free flowing living area, which encompasses traditional Thai design along with contemporary modern lines.

The total living area is 600sqm and comes with a Chanote land title.

This villa is a real work of art and includes all furniture and fittings for only 34,900,000 baht.
